ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

- Develop and periodically review objectives and targets to support this policy with the overall aim to improving our environmental performance in reducing our carbon footprint;
- Reduce whenever practicable , the environmental impact of our site and transport operations;
- Seek to minimise our impact upon the local community;
- Exercise control , as far as is possible over the environmental impacts arising as a result of work being undertaken on our behalf by any of our sub- contractors , suppliers and maintenance contractors;
- Review this policy annually or in the light of any new knowledge, changing legislation or public concerns;

Provide appropriate training to our employees, to enable them to implement this environmental policy and we have appointed the Managing Director to be in charge, who will have overall responsibility for ensuring that our environmental duties are implemented and maintained in keeping with the implied terms, in accordance with our environmental policy.
